I spoke today with Harry Reppert and Brad Statley of RMC Lonestar regarding the outcome of their investigation and for ~~the~~ repairs. Mr. Statley indicated that when the top of the subject UST had been uncovered, the tank seemed to have "settled" to the point where an air pocket developed at the high end of the tank. This air pocket ~~was~~ couldn't be removed through normal means associated with the integrity test process. An additional vent was apparently installed at the end of the tank where ~~an~~ the air pocket developed, with a valve which can be actuated during future tests to bleed off this air pocket.

Champion reportedly retested the tank Nov. 26 or 27 with no leak observed. I requested that a copy of this latest test result, as well as a brief narrative describing the work ~~at~~ performed, be submitted.

I also reminded Mr. Reppert about the \$744 deposit request by this Dept. in the Nov. 16, 1990 correspondence. Mr. Reppert indicated this deposit was forthcoming.

I placed a call to Harry Reppert today regarding this Dept's recent receipt of two (2) UST precision tank test results, dated Oct 25 and Nov 9, 1990, for the 4,000 gallon unleaded tank at the Sunol site. The results of these tests indicate the system failed during both test sessions, conducted Oct. 19 and 31, 1990.

Notes by the test technicians, W. Campbell and Bert Madison, indicate the tests could not be performed as they were unable to keep product in the test standpipe, and the tests were consequently terminated.

An Unauthorized Leak Report was completed this day. Mr. Reppert was requested to submit a brief report regarding the nature of the leak and any repairs.

- a little ponding on surface
- area ~~50~~ x 50' (2500 ft²)
- "road base" laid on top to absorb and mitigate fire hazard
- 40' depth to ground H₂O
- still trying to substantiate amount of material lost
 - appears to be in the 2700 gallon range
- wants to do borings to assess verticle impact of spill
- suggested that they get out tomorrow and begin excavating material

- he said he will be contacting Geo Strategies (Chris Palmer)
- I said the material can be stockpiled on Visqueen awaiting treatment

Aug 22

- Call w/ Harry Reppert this A.M.
- RMC Lonestar has contracted with Gettler-Ryan to begin excavation today
- RMC's geologist provided some hope that the verticle migration may be limited due to the large amount of "fines" in the interstices of the gravel fragments
- We talked about sampling sidewalls and bottom of the excavation every ~ 200 sq-ft, or so.
- We talked, too, about a final report
