Requested the following additional info before considering closure:

1) The area of excavation shown on the revised figure, dated Sept 29 '98 was erroneous for Area A. This map indicates that areas around Former Sample R-9 and Truck TP-5, hot zones, were not excavated, when

in fact they were, according to Gary Tompkins. Mr. Tompkins will supply info on true excavation info

2) Requested info on ^{background} phosphorus levels to compare w/ concentrations on site.

Mr. Tompkins stated that levels of potassium phosphorus, exceeding levels on site, are okayed for home use in products in stores. I requested that he submit documentation to that effect.

3) Requested clarification on what "1.8D" means for the contaminant 2,4-D.

4) Check w/ Wynan Hong, Zone 7, to see whether only one permit issued for ^{temp.} boring installation & closure.
