- 09/29/98 Spoke to Madhulla began, County Rate Assessment Specialist. Since there are no threshold values established for phosphorus resulting from fertilizers (only threshold levels existing are for white phosphorus which results from explosives), the closure will be granted on condition that attempts be made to pave over as much of the site as possible. Any uncovered areas must have a minimum of 1-foot of clean soil placed on top. An "As Built" plan must be submitted to County after construction is completed and disclosures required. In the future, if new information indicates that remaining contaminant concentrations pose a threat to human health or the environment, the case may be re-opened.
- 09/29/98 Will Brubaker, RWQCB → stated that 2,4-D is a breakdown product of DDT. White phosphorus has threshold values, but white phosphorus results from explosives.
