Dear Ms. Mayhew:

I am in receipt of the summary report and laboratory results submitted by DSS contractors for the above referenced property. A TPH spill from one of the pieces of equipment present at the referenced property led to an investigation and subsequent remediation. The contaminated area was excavated on September 2, 1997 and confirmatory soil samples were collected from the excavation pit and from the excavated soil (stockpiled).

The laboratory results of the confirmation soil samples collected from the excavation pit indicate the presence of extractable total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) in insignificant concentrations. However, the laboratory results of the composite sample collected from the stockpiled soil indicate the presence of diesel up to 7100 ppm.

Based on the information submitted to this Department, no further remedial action is required on the property. However, the stockpiled soil on site needs to be disposed at an appropriate facility within 45 days from the date of this letter and all the pertinent receipt/manifest documenting the disposal should be submitted to this Department. Also, the excavation should be filled with clean soil immediately to avoid the hazards present due to an open pit.
