Guy Roy said the samples used in the P.T. water extraction without agitation was taken by Papey. I asked him how did Papey get samples 14' down, he said with a ladder. When I told him I said a month ago samples had to be taken with a backhoe, he said Papey already took them. I said I question the integrity of the samples and want a resampling. Mr. Roy said he will contact RWQCB for their feeling.

4/28/88 Mark Thompson said to draft a letter addressed to both Pujaly and Gloria Banagan and inform them RWQCB wants them to get a consultant.

- 1/13/88 Lester Feldman recommended a soil extraction of the contaminated P-2-P soil with D.I. water that would simulate rain water to determine whether rain water would cause the contamination to spread.
- 1/14/88 Guy Seto spoke to Hon-Tsing Su, Cal. Mgr. of Clayton Environmental and asked if they could do the above recommend extraction for a 96 hrs period. He said they could at a cost of approx. \$250.00. I instructed Martin Rasmussen that he should contact Dujely and Clayton Env. and set up the sampling and keep me informed.
- 1/19/88 Dujely called and I informed him that Martin of Erickson was going to set-up the testing of the soil using water as the extraction medium.
- 4/25/88 Gloria Banghan informed me two drums of liquid waste was taken from her property (Duganly)
