Dear Mr. Prall,

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the case file for the subject site cleanup program (SCP) case. The 4444 Berth 30 site contains references to a waste management unit (WMU) proposed to accommodate approximately 14,500 cubic yards of lead-impacted soil. It is unclear to ACEH if the WMU has been constructed as there are no post-construction monitoring reports in the ACEH case file evaluating the unit performance, as outlined in the May 1993 report entitled *Report of Waste Discharge, Landfill Design, and Closure and Post-Closure Maintenance Plan, Berth 30*, prepared by Geomatrix.

Please report the status of the WMU to ACEH and upload any post-construction monitoring reports by the date specified below.

The ACEH case file also contains a correspondence from ACEH to the Port of Oakland (Port), dated October 29, 1992, authorizing the excavation of petroleum contaminated soil. It is unclear to ACEH if the excavation occurred as no report is located in the case file documenting the excavation activities.

Please provide the report documenting the excavation activities to ACEH and upload any additional reports documenting environmental investigations, remediation, or cleanups that have occurred at the subject site by the date specified below.

### Technical Report Request

Please upload technical reports to the ACEH ftp site (Attention: Keith Nowell), and to the SWRCB Geotracker website, in accordance with the following schedule:

- **May 4, 2015 – Waste Management Unit and Excavation Status** (provide via Email correspondence)
- **May 4, 2015 – Waste Management Unit and Excavation Reports**
