Hi Lisa,

I've had a chance to followup on our conversations last week. I have found old hand written notes that indicate the soil bores were not done (according to J. Quarle himself apparently); they had only been proposed in the plan for work (Work Plan). If you can forward those cell tower soil reports you mentioned last week, they may be helpful.

If you would like to move forward on the project, the County would need to receive funds to allow that. There was a letter requesting funds that was sent on December 21, 2009 (addressed to Henry and Joann Hermenez at 16081 Mateo Street). Hopefully it was received, but it may not have been acted on. I've attached a copy for your reference.

Since this is a UST (Underground Storage Tank) site, I'm not sure why this is classified as a SLIC (Spills, Leaks, Investigations, and Cleanups) site which is self funded, rather than being in the LOP (Local Oversight Program) which is funded by the State, and has a Cleanup Fund (USTCF) for reimbursement of some / most of costs associated with an investigation. You may want to retain a consultant to see if it would be warranted for you to try to get into that program. (It's downsizing now due to the state basically being broke, but it might be worth exploring that angle).
