Russell,

I did get your voice mail from Wednesday, but had not had a chance to speak with someone until late yesterday. As we knew the case will be transferred, to Barbara Jakub (639-1287). At this point, I would not upload the information you were in the process of scanning; however, I think it will still be useful at some point. Fortunately and unfortunately ACEH (and all other local agencies) has been tasked by the state to conduct case reviews of all cases between now and June 30, 2010. That process will take some time, but you will also be guaranteed a review of the case in that time. ACEH is attempting to have this done by January 30, at least the vast majority. Recommendations would likely follow thereafter. So for now, the county is only asking that the site be claimed in Geotracker, and then it's back to a waiting period. As I think I had said previously, the county has been understaffed, and will now be working through the case load now that it's been redistributed and reduced by the addition of myself; it'll still take some time. Hopefully this helps...
