Regarding the above-referenced site, although the Corrective Action Pilot Test Workplan (dated March 19, 2008) has been approved, my client, Mr. Cary Greyson, is not in a position financially to cover the costs for the pilot test. Please note that although my client is in the UST Cleanup Fund, with the slumping economy, the State in financial crisis, my client's deteriorating financial capability, and the unknown future of the UST CF and the increasing length of time to receive payments, my client is just not in a position financially to cover the costs for the pilot test or even any additional quarterly groundwater sampling events.

On behalf of my client, I am requesting that no further work be performed at the property until my client's financial position improves, along with a significant improvement in the UST CF payment schedule.
