Dear Mr. Supple:

Provided herein is an addendum to the Broadbent and Associates, Inc. (BAI) September 2, 2008 *Soil and Ground-Water Investigation Work Plan* (herein referred to as the Work Plan). In response to the Work Plan, the Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) issued the September 17, 2008 letter stating, "to adequately characterize the soil and groundwater in the vicinity of soil sample DP-3, an additional monitoring well located in line and approximately midway between proposed MW-2 and SB-6 appears necessary."

Accordingly, additional monitor well MW-4 will be installed at the location depicted in Drawing 1. Proposed well location MW-3 has been moved approximately 25 feet to the northeast (from the original location included in the Work Plan) to provide adequate distance between wells MW-3 and MW-4. Soil sampling and well construction details for MW-4 will be the same as details provided in the Work Plan for wells MW-1 through MW-3.

The ACEH September 17, 2008 letter requested that the Soil and Water Investigation Report and Fourth Quarter, 2008 Report be submitted by November 26, 2008. The investigation activities will include: utility clearance of site including the use of a private utility locate company; installation of borings and construction of wells; well development; monitoring and sampling of wells; survey of newly installed wells; and completion of report. It is therefore recommended that the deadline for submittal of the report be revised to December 31, 2008.

Once the ACEH has approved the above discussed revisions to the Work Plan, Stratus Environmental, Inc. will be directed to execute the work. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us at (530) 566-1400.


