The above referenced site is a Site Cleanup Program (SCP) case that is under the regulatory oversight of Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) for the investigation and cleanup of gasoline from a pipeline spill. A break in a gasoline pipeline released approximately 29,400 gallons of gasoline on a hillside area adjacent to Calaveras Road in August 2005. Spray from the pipeline break extended downslope from the release to Calaveras Road. A portion of Calaveras Road was damaged by the gasoline and was replaced. Approximately 100 cubic yards of contaminated soil was removed from the site following the release. A soil vapor extraction system operated sporadically at the site from November 2005 until July 23, 2009. Site investigation and cleanup activities have been completed and it does not appear that residual contamination presents a risk to human health and the environment. Therefore, ACEH is considering closure of the case.

This notice is being sent to the current occupants and landowners of surrounding properties and known interested parties for this site. The public is invited to review and comment on the potential closure of the case.
