Mr. Wickham,

I wanted to update you with regard to the operation of the SVE system at the CPL Sunol site. An SVE system was operated from December 22nd, 2008 through the week of February 6th, 2009. As you may recall, the SVE system used electricity as a power source rather than the use of a propane powered generator. During routine O&M on February 10th, 2009, Stratus, our subcontractor, discovered that PG&E had turned off the power service to the SVE system sometime after February 3rd, 2009. URS investigated the issue and learned from CPL that the invoice from PG&E had been held up in CPL's accounting system, causing PG&E to discontinue service.

At this time, URS decided to have Stratus remove the SVE system from the site for two reasons. First, CPL was unsure when PG&E would be paid and to date the issue has not been resolved. CPL is actively working to resolve this issue. Second, the URS/Stratus contract work order term of service expired and URS decided to retain another contractor.

URS has actively been seeking a new subcontractor and is in the process of contracting with Mako Industries to continue SVE system operations. URS received a bid from Mako March 24th, 2009 for the SVE system and will begin developing a plan for Mako to install a new SVE system at the site in the near future. We will notify you when we have the replacement SVE system operating.
