Jenny,

As prescribed in the SWRCB Resolution, provided that sites do not have specific needs that would require quarterly monitoring, the site may go to a 1st and 3rd quarter semi-annual groundwater monitoring schedule. However, the Springtown Gas site on Bluebell in Livermore had recent interim remedial action. Therefore, the site-specific needs potentially may warrant more frequent monitoring than semi-annual monitoring. Please let me know Geological Technic's recommendations regarding whether semi-annual monitoring will be sufficient to evaluate the interim remedial action.

We have 2 sites that you are regulator for:

Arrow Rentals, L Street, Livermore:

We are currently not performing any GWM until the remedial system is installed. No change will occur.

Springtown, Bluebell Street. Livermore:

This site is currently on quarterly monitoring and we already performed 1st Quarter. Should we skip the 2nd Quarter and monitor 3rd quarter which will transition this site to 1 & 3 Q events?
