Dear Responsible Parties:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the case file including the *Site Closure Summary Report* (SCSR), dated August 7, 2014, which was prepared by Frank Goldman, Environmental and Hydrological Consulting, for the subject site. The SCSR expresses the opinion that the case associated with the former service station, which operated on the subject property for more than 20 years, meets the State Water Resources Control Board's (SWRCBs) Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (LTCP) and recommends closure of the former gasoline underground storage tank (UST) portion of the case. ACEH concurs with the recommendation and is proceeding with case closure of the petroleum UST case.

However, in addition to the UST system fuel release, the presence of substantial concentrations of trichloroethene (TCE) in shallow groundwater has been reported beneath the site. The SCSR recommends that any subsurface investigation of the identified dissolved TCE plume should be accompanied by the naming of all other potential responsible parties in the vicinity of the subject site. However, ACEH, in its evaluation of the data is of the opinion the groundwater data does not rule out the potential for an on-site source of the TCE plume.

Therefore, based on the presence of TCE beneath the site, ACEH has opened a Voluntary Remedial Action Program (VRAP) case. Please send a check in the amount of \$6,000.00 payable to Alameda County Environmental Health by the date specified below. This deposit may or may not be sufficient to provide all necessary regulatory oversight. ACEH will deduct actual costs incurred based upon the hourly rate specified below. If these funds are insufficient, additional deposit will be requested. Otherwise, any unused monies will be refunded to you or your designee.

The deposit is authorized in Section 6.92.040L of the Alameda County Ordinance Code. Work on this project is being debited at the Ordinance specified rate, currently \$204.00 per hour. Please send your check to the attention of our Finance Department. ACEH requests that you include the site address on the check in addition to including the case number, **RO0003180**, for the VRAP case.

Request for Funds -

• **September 25, 2015** - Check submittal in the amount of \$6,000.00 payable to Alameda County Environmental Health.

If ACEH has not received the deposit by the closure date of the fuel leak case, RO0002905, ACEH will initiate transfer of your case to the San Francisco Bay Region, Regional Water Quality Control Board (SFBR-RWQCB).
