The City has been meeting with Chevron to discuss Chevron's allegations that the City contributed to the contamination at the site. At this time the City has not seen any evidence to support that allegation.

The City does not believe that these discussions about monetary contributions should hold up the approved schedule for testing and developing a remediation plan and ask that you not extend the schedule for these activities.

Should incontrovertible proof be provided that the City did contribute to contamination of the site, the City will agree to pay for its incremental share of the testing and remediation costs, but again that should not hold up the project any longer than it already has.
