Hi Jerry,

We are planning to install the monitoring wells at the end of the month at Mills Square Park in Livermore. In the work plan submitted on June 10, 2009, and in the subsequent revisions approved by ACEH, CRA proposed to install 4-inch wells. Due to site logistics, we will need to use a limited-access rig to install most of the monitoring wells and will have difficulty using 10-inch augers to depth. Therefore, CRA proposes to install 2-inch wells for all the proposed monitoring wells on and offsite.

Please let us know if you concur with the change in well diameter.
