I cannot give an estimate as to when a case will close as closure is dependent upon cleanup results achieved and monitoring data. You may wish to discuss scheduled activities with Chevron. It may be possible to move forward with a project prior to closure depending upon the location relative to site contamination. In such cases, the responsible parties can put together a plan for development prior to closure.

We expect to have a response to the human health risk assessment within the next 30 days.

The August 6<sup>th</sup> letter to Chevron mentioned that three more ground water monitoring reports are due to ACEH. The third being due in April on 2013. Can we expect the case to be closed after this date or will more monitoring be required?
