AEI Consultants (AEI) has prepared this letter documenting the destruction of the monitoring wells at the property located at 325 Martin Luther King Jr. Way in Oakland, California (Figure 1: Site Location Map). This report has been prepared on behalf of Jane Allen, the property owner, and summarizes the destruction of groundwater monitoring wells MW-1 through MW-3, soil vapor sampling points VS-1 through VS-5, and remediation wells IW-1 through IW-5. The work was completed March 18, 2014, and was requested by the Alameda County Environmental Health Services (ACEH) in a letter dated February 26, 2014 as part of the case closure activities.

Background

The subject property is located on the northwestern corner of the intersection of Martin Luther King Jr. Way and 4th Street in a mixed commercial and industrial area of Oakland. The property measures approximately 100 feet along Martin Luther King and approximately 150 feet along 4th Street with the property building covering essentially 100% of the site. The building is currently vacant, but was previously occupied by Pucci Enterprises as warehouse space and cold storage freezers.

AEI issued a *Site Status Update and Case Closure Evaluation* dated November 5, 2013 which discussed historical environmental site activities as well as recent remedial activities at the site. The report included a case closure evaluation which outlined current site conditions and why the site should be considered for case closure. The ACEH concurred with AEI's recommendation in a letter dated February 26, 2014. The following document contains details for the completed well destruction activities.

Well Destruction

Prior to initiating the well destruction activities, well destruction permits (Permit No. W2014-0235 through W2014-0239) dated March 5, 2014 were obtained from the Alameda County Public Works Agency (ACPWA). A copy of the permits is presented in Appendix A: Permit Documentation. The ACPWA was contacted with the schedule for the completion of the work and ACPWA personnel was onsite during the grouting activities. Decommissioning activities were performed under the direct supervision of AEI personnel, under direct supervision of a California licensed professional geologist.

The wells were destroyed by Environmental Control Associates (C 57- License No. 695970) by tremie grouting, as approved by the Alameda County inspector. Well depths ranged from 5.5 to 18 feet bgs and type I/II neat cement was used (mixed at approximately 6 gallons of fresh water per 94 pound bag of cement). The grout was allowed to settle and each well was topped off following settlement. The well boxes were removed and the surface was restored with concrete to match the adjacent floor.

Well Destruction Documentation

California Department of Water Resources (DWR) 188 forms for each destroyed well were prepared and submitted to the ACPWA on March 20, 2014

Closing

The destruction of the groundwater monitoring wells completes all required activities for the subject site. No further activities or reporting related to the hydrocarbon release is planned at this time.





- 9. Remove the Christy box or similar structure.

Destroy well by grouting neat cement with a tremie pipe or pressure grouting (25 psi for 5min.) to the bottom of the well and by filling with neat cement to three (3-5) feet below surface grade. Allow the sealing material to spill over the top of the casing to fill any annular space between casing and soil.

After the seal has set, backfill the remaining hole with concrete or compacted material to match existing conditions.

10. Copy of approved drilling permit must be on site at all times. Failure to present or show proof of the approved permit application on site shall result in a fine of \$500.00.

Vapor monitoring wells constructed with pvc pipe less than 2" shall be overdrilled to total depth.

Vapor monitoring wells constructed with 2" pvc pipe or larger may be grouted by tremie pipe (any depth) or pressure grouted (less than 30', 25 psi for 5 min).
