

Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.



Existence of Unauthorized Release

On February 22, 2000 one (UST) was removed from the site. Soil and groundwater sampling conducted in conjunction with the UST removal detected elevated concentrations of total petroleum hydrocarbon as gasoline (TPHg) and total petroleum hydrocarbon as diesel (TPHd). The case was transferred from the City of Oakland Fire Department to Alameda County Environmental Health in September 2006. During the UST removal, up to 920 parts per million (ppm) TPHg and 850 ppm TPHd were detected in soil, while groundwater samples collected from the UST excavation pit detected up to 3,300 parts per billion (ppb) benzene, 34,000 ppb TPHg and 7,400 ppb TPHd.

Responsible Party Identification

Steffi Zimmerman is the primary responsible party because she was the owner of the property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).
