Alameda County Environmental Health's (ACEH) October 14, 2009 technical comment letter response to the Livermore-Pleasanton Fire Dept.'s (LPPD) September 25, 2009 comment letter on the Closure Plan dated June 19, 2009 for the former hot mix asphalt plant area (AOC#1), the idle truck maintenance area (AOC#2), and the heavy equipment maintenance and wash rack area (AOC#3) at the former Hanson Aggregates Radum Facility located at 3000 Busch Road, Pleasanton, California, requires a Revised Closure Plan to be submitted to both the County and the LPPD on or by December 1, 2009. Hanson, the original owner of the property, and Legacy Partners, the current owner of the property except for a 15 acre parcel designated as AOC#1, are in the process of discussing closure responsibilities which has not been fully resolved.
