For your case, the next requested report is a Work Plan that should include the requested background information and complete descriptions of proposed sampling methods. After Alameda County Environmental Health provides comments on the Work Plan, the proposed soil and groundwater sampling may be implemented. The results of the proposed investigation will be presented in a report that includes tables, figures, and text with an evaluation of the results and conclusions and recommendations.
