## Hi Mark:

Happy New year. Just to update you on the progress of work at the subject site, 2145 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Oakland (RO2945: 2145 35TH AVE.,) we completed the field soil gas sampling on Friday, January 2, 2015. We expect to receive the lab results in two weeks. Next phase of work, as you know, is the excavation of shallow soil, impacted with lead above 80 mg/kg. These are six locations onsite (10'X10'). Instead of collecting the confirmatory soil samples after the excavation, I will collect them before, to delineate the extent of the lead impact. The sample collection will be according to the approved workplan. Then, we excavate the shallow soil to the extent needed to bring the soil level to below 80 mg/kg. We intend to collect the confirmatory soil samples for lead analysis, possibly this week (week starting January 5, 2015).

Groundwater concentrations look about the same; slightly higher concentrations in MW-2 and slightly shallower gw; probably picking something up off the soil.

I agree that groundwater sampling is providing limited information, but let's keep the interval at annual; you might have closure before the next event if the soil vapor does not indicate a risk.
