Dear Mr. Altwarg, Mr. Saur, Mr. Arnold, and Mr. Garnica:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has received correspondence from Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) dated December 13, 2007 that responded to the Notice of Responsibility issued by ACEH on November 28, 2007. PG&E's correspondence requested that ACEH re-consider designation of PG&E as the primary or active responsible party and requested that if PG&E is designated as a primary responsible party, that the designation be limited to two underground storage tanks at the site.

The Notice of Responsibility is a standard form used by Local Oversight Programs for fuel leak cases throughout California. As stated on the Notice of Responsibility form, a primary or active responsible party is identified, "For the purposes of implementing section 25297.15." Health and Safety Code Section 25297.15 requires the primary or active responsible party to notify all current record owners of feet title before the local agency considers cleanup or site closure proposals or issues a closure letter. The identification of a primary or active responsible party on the Notice of Responsibility is not intended to designate additional responsibilities or liabilities beyond the requirements of Health and Safety Code Section 25297.15. The responsible parties identified on the Notice of Responsibility and in the heading above the subject line of this correspondence are jointly and severally liable. Since PG&E has already complied with Health and Safety Code section 25297.15 regarding the initial notification, we do not see a reason to revise the designation of PG&E as the primary or active responsible party at this time. However, if a responsible party other than PG&E has a more active role in implementation of the work, the other responsible party can be designated the primary or active responsible party for the purposes of implementing the notification requirements of section 25297.15. Notifications per Health and Safety Code section 25297.15 are for the case and not individual USTs; therefore, each case has only one primary or active responsible party.
