This communication concerns

Steven Plunkett was formerly the case officer on this matter, but he informs me that you now are. (Note that in my email to Mr. Plunkett of a weeke ago, May 20^{th,} I erroneously identified the property as "2659" in the subject line of the email; the correct address is indeed "2650 Magnolia St." as stated in the body of that email.)

Currently this property has no groundwater monitoring wells. The possibility of needing to install them was apparently left open by a very small irregularity in only one of the chemicals picked up in an analysis of the groundwater done after removal 1930's-era gasoline tanks removed in 2008. My understanding is that the small discrepancy would only be relevant if the water were to be used as untreated human drinking water, an unlikely event in West Oakland. I'm writing to request that you decide that we do not need to install groundwater monitoring wells on this property. Linford-Magnolia Properties (a partnership made up of two siblings and the surviving son of the third sibling) sold the site, the partnership's only asset, in January 2009. As a condition of the sale the partnership remained responsible for any pre-

sale groundwater conditions caused by the tanks installed by a previous owner. The partnership took out environmental insurance (with a rather high deductible) which only runs for a few more months. We would appreciate a decision from you, hopefully closing your file. If you are not the person who can decide to close this file, I would greatly appreciate your letting me know, at your very earliest convenience, who can close it.
