# Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

#### Existence of Unauthorized Release

In June 2007, two USTs were removed and soil samples were collected during the UST removal and excavation. During the removal of the UST, a large hole was detected in the UST and visual evidence of petroluem hydrocarbon impact was detected in soil. An unauthorized release was documented on June 21, 2007 Results from the soil sampling detected Total Petroleum Hydrocarbon as gasoline (TPHg) and benzene at concentrations of up to 1500 milligrams per kilogram (ppm) and 0.8 ppm, respectively. In addition, a grab groundwater sample was collected from the excavation pit and TPHg was detected at concentrations of up to 830 parts per billion

### Responsible Party Identification

Lindford Magnolia Properties is the primary responsible party because the unauthorized release occurred while Lindford Magnolia Properties owned the property (definition 3). In addition, Lindford Magnolia Properties had control of an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (definition 4).
