Normally the consultant submits the report, but the county has a perjury statement cover sheet that's required to be signed by the RP (basically stating they haven't had you tell fibs – or "unduly influenced the work product recommendations and conclusions"...). But the RP can submit, and the perjury statement would still be required. It's also submitted as a PDF to the county's ftp website. See the attachments to any of our letters for more details. Hopefully the report will discuss any potential signs of contamination from deeper excavations (petroleum contam was a potential issue detailed in a soil and groundwater management plan), but if that wasn't part of your contract then it'll come back to the RP to cover that I guess.
