Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the case file for the above referenced site including the *Site Management Plan*, (SMP) dated April 8, 2014, and the Site Conceptual Model Addendum, dated February 24, 2014 (received April 30, 2014). The SMP was submitted on your behalf by Adanta, Inc. (Adanta). Thank you for submitting the SMP, and thank you for more recently submitting the entire Site Conceptual Model Addendum as some of the figures and tables from this document were requested to be incorporated into the SMP (see the Technical Comment below). Based on the review of the case file ACEH requests that you address the following technical comment and send us the documents requested below.

TECHNICAL COMMENTS

1. SMP Missing Elements - ACEH has reviewed the SMP for consistency with requests contained in technical comments in previous directive letters, in particular the directive letters dated February 7, 2014 and March 17, 2014. Both directive letters contained several technical comments that requested inclusion of a number of items in the SMP. Specifically, this includes, but may not be limited to, Technical Comment 2e, 2f, and 2g from the February 7, 2014 email directive letter, and Technical Comment 3ii, 3iii, 3iv, 3v from the March 17, 2014 directive letter. These items do not appear to have been referenced in, or incorporated into, the SMP at present. Please note that potential areas where contamination has either been previously identified or has the potential to remain, may not be limited to the central sump area at the site.

These reports are being requested pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party in response to an unauthorized release from a petroleum UST system, and require your compliance with this request.
