Scott and Nadya,

Thanks for the note on the pending soil vapor sampling next week. Please be cognizant of DTSC guidance on not sampling within 5 days of "significant rain events" (>0.5 inches in a 24 hr period). I've not tracked weather closely, but we are expecting 1 – 1.5 inches sometime next week in the East Bay. Due to the close proximity of the rain next week, please document rainfall relative to your sampling event in future reporting.
