Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) issued a letter dated September 17, 2013 approving the Cardno ERI Work Plan dated July 22, 2013. The first soil vapor sampling event (SVS1 through SVS3) was conducted on March 6, and 7, 2014. These results were included in the Soil, Soil Vapor, and Groundwater Investigation Report and Site Conceptual Model Report dated May 2, 2014 (ACEH approved an extension for this report to May 5, 2014).
