Edd Clark & Associates, Inc. (EC&A) recently did a soil and groundwater investigation at a property in Alameda County: 1530-1540 Solano Ave, Albany, CA.

My question is this - the site (1530-1540 Solano Ave) had very low levels of fuel hydrocarbons and solvents detected in soil and/or groundwater samples collected from the site. Are you the person with whom I should discuss whether or not to submit an Unauthorized Release Form? I just want to get a feel for whether or not this is worth opening up as an actual open case or not (doesn't seem like it to me). In the event that you are the person with whom I should speak, I've attached the two laboratory reports from this investigation.
