Thank you for attending the meeting today regarding Site Cleanup Program Case RO0002981- Red Hanger Kleaners- 6235-6239 College Avenue, Oakland. We found the meeting most productive. As you are aware, Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) is providing regulatory oversight of the investigation and cleanup at the subject site due to releases of volatile organic chemicals (VOCs) to the subsurface from past dry cleaner activities.

As presented in the meeting, ACDEH's primary concern is the potential health risk due to exposure from VOCs via vapor intrusion to indoor air. As these conditions may exist at your property, located at 6251-6255 College Avenue, we expressed concern that building occupants may be exposed to VOCs at concentrations above action levels.

We were informed the foundation slab and grade beam(s) at your property were recently replaced for most of the building. As requested at the meeting please submit of a copy of the construction detail for the recently upgraded/replaced foundation, including the specification sheet associated with "taped vapor barrier" identified at the meeting. Please provide these documents as electronic mail attachments, Attention: Keith Nowell, by the date specified below.

Additionally, we discussed preparation of a work plan to evaluate sub-slab/soil gas conditions at your property. The work plan should be presented to ACDEH for our review and approval prior to its implementation. Please provide the work plan as an electronic mail attachment, Attention: Keith Nowell, by the date specified below.
