Duration: Approximately 20 minutes

I received a phone call from Jonathon Redding, attorney representing the property owner of the subject site. His call appeared to be in response to a call yesterday from Mr. Steve Karmac of P&D Environmental (P&D) regarding permitting of additional soil vapor extraction (SVE) wells. Yesterday I indicated to Mr. Karmac I could not approved the work until I knew where the proposed wells would be installed and requested submittal of a brief work plan addendum for my review.

During my conversation with Mr. Redding, I noted I had received an email from P&D. I mentioned this to Mr. Redding; however, the nature of our conversation prevented me from reviewing the email during our phone conversation.

Mr. Redding indicated that he did not need work plan approval as a work plan had previously been approved that included the language "enhance it as necessary" – indicating the number of SVE could be changed without further authorization from ACEH. He said the letter was written by Dilan Roe (the ACEH Program Manager) in my absence and also in a phone conversation with her. I said I was unaware of these communications and would look through the case file. In any event, I needed to be made aware of the boring locations prior to approving the work.
