Paul King of P&D Environmental and I exchanged phone calls this afternoon regarding RHK. I had called to inquire about the status of site activities and inquire if he heard any Mr. Patten (I have previously referred to Mr. Patten as Mr. Paxton). Mr. King indicated he had not heard from Mr. Patten since the two calls last Friday afternoon. Currently P&D was cutting the slab inside the former dry cleaner suite.

In order to construct a time line, I asked Mr. King when the two calls with Mr. Patten occurred. The first was around 2 PM. During that call Mr. Patten indicated he was experiencing health issues which may be attributed to P&D's activities. The second call was made after 4 PM. In between the calls, Mr. Patten sent an email to our CUPA complaining of fumes escaping out of the ground that are making him tired, having trouble breathing, feeling light-headed, etc. Meanwhile, Paul King contacted me to make me aware of Mr. Patten's condition.

In the second call with Mr. Patten, Mr. King says he discussed the exposure data, including findings to date, conversations with the DTSC toxicologist, and PID readings from current activities. Mr. King thought the conversation put Mr. Patten at ease.
