Hello Mr. Simas:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the case file. The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) adopted the Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (LTCP) in August 2012 for the purpose of establishing consistent statewide case closure criteria for low-threat petroleum Underground Storage Tank (UST) sites.

I am your new caseworker and I would like to set up a meeting with you at our office to discuss a review of the site's status in comparison with the LTCP and to develop a path to closure for your case.
