Phone call with Brian Gwinn of Blue Rock Environmental. He was aware that there had been complaints of headache, nausea from employees at the site last week when HVPDE unit started. He was not aware of recent complaints. CalClean has a permit for oxidizer. Exhaust from unit should be similar to exhaust from automobile. The unit has an onboard diesel generator. The original exhaust was about 13 feet high but Calclean extended it to about 18 feet high after complaints. The building has an on-roof intake for HVAC system. Brian believes that everyone should be receiving similar air throughout the building. The employees who appear to be affected are the ones near the front of building closest to the HVDPE unit. Brian indicated that no one had reported an odor.

The influent concentration is about 480 ppm which translates to about 12 pounds per day. They would like to continue to operate the HVDPE until Tuesday am.
