I wanted to followup on the attached Request for Funds that was sent in early September, as ACEH has not received a check. I had been waiting for the City of Albany to get back to me on some changes to the Land Use Covenant (LUC) that are probably pretty minor, but this is a standard procedure. Since I've not heard back, I thought it appropriate to move the case into the 30 day public comment period for closure. Once that is complete, and assuming no comments are forthcoming, as confirmed by an ACEH communication, ACEH could approve well destructions. Closure would follow the submittal of a well destruction report, and generation of a closure summary document by ACEH; however, without funds ACEH will not be able to provide further oversight, including well destruction approval and closure of the case. I did want to make sure you had received the letter to preclude these possibilities.
