I did receive the hard copies of the figures – thank you.

As previously discussed, my review of the case file and the State Water Resources Control Board's GeoTracker website indicates that the site is in non-compliance status with respect to the requirements for electronic data submittal requirements (see attached file –DIR_L_2010-08-20). At present, in addition to the two Ninyo & Moore Phase II investigation reports, missing data and documents include, but may not be limited to analytical data (EDF), boring logs (GEO_BORE), and site maps (GEO_MAP), and older reports (GEO_REPORT) including:

- Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (Basics Environmental, December 14, 2008)
- Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (AEI, October 29, 2008)
- Limited Phase II Environmental Site Sampling Report (Basics Environmental, March 16, 2009)

Please work with your client, Crown Chevrolet, to upload all pertinent data and reports. Please see the attached file for limited additional details, and the state GeoTracker website for full details. ACEH requests notification of, and a list of the documents uploaded to Geotracker.

Hi Dilan -

You should have received hard copies of the figures you requested in full size. Please let me know if you didn't receive those.

Also, you had a question about the timing of the case. The Basics Phase II was finalized in March 2009. That was submitted to the RWQCB in April 2009, although a case had not yet been opened. It looks like a case was opened at ACEH in late 2009 (see attached correspondence file). ACEH sent Crown a letter on March 24, 2010, requesting an UST Unauthorized Release Form and additional investigation, referencing the Basics Phase II. Following that, AMEC performed several investigations, the results of which have been posted on GeoTracker (PDFs and EDFs). Based on that timing, I don't believe it's necessary have the Basics Phase II EDFs on GeoTracker.

However, we are working on trying to obtain the Ninyo & Moore EDFs to post on GeoTracker, but do not have those yet. That investigation was performed as part of due diligence by a 3rd party, not on behalf of Crown Chevrolet, and we don't currently have access to laboratory EDFs.
