Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) is recommending the fuel leak case at the above referenced site for case closure. As you are aware a site investigation and groundwater monitoring for underground storage tank leaks has been performed at the subject property to which you are named as the primary or active responsible party.

Public Participation

Public participation is a requirement for the case closure process. In order to notify potentially affected members of the public of the potential fuel leak case closure, ACEH has distributed the attached *Notification of Potential Case Closure* to addresses in the immediate vicinity. The *Public Notification of Potential Case Closure of Fuel Leak Case* requests that landowners or residents submit any comments or questions to ACEH regarding potential case closure by May 6, 2013. ACEH will consider all comments from the public prior to potential case closure.

Request for Monitoring Well Destruction Scheduling

As part of an attempt to expedite closures, and with the recognition that coordination of well decommissioning is a long lead item, ACEH requests that you schedule well decommissioning for approximately two weeks after closure of the public comment period for the site. Please contact the Alameda County Public Works Agency at (510) 567-6791 or online, to obtain the required permits. After written ACEH concurrence (email or other) that there have been no comments, you would be free to proceed. Should there be public comments, then there would be sufficient time to cancel (and / or reschedule) the date and not incur a cost from the drilling company. Please provide notification to ACEH by the date identified below, that you have contracted a licensed drilling contractor for the decommissioning of the remaining well.




Figure 1: Aerial View of Property (Google Earth, 2013)

Summary – This fact sheet has been prepared to inform community members and other interested parties of potential case closure for a fuel leak case at the City of Alameda Police Department located at 1555 Oak Street in Alameda, California. The property is currently occupied by the Alameda Police Department (Figure 1).

The existing underground storage tank (UST) system containing diesel was originally installed in 1977 and was upgraded in 1999. A groundwater sample collected from a monitoring well installed in 1986 adjacent to the UST contained 1,600 parts per billion (ppb) total petroleum hydrocarbons as diesel (TPHD).

On December 28, 2011, three soil borings were advanced to determine the extent of the previously

reported groundwater contamination and the monitoring well was sampled. Soil samples from the borings collected at or just above the soil-water interface and did not contain any detectable petroleum hydrocarbons. The only detectable contamination in groundwater was 270 ppb TPHD, collected from a boring located approximately ten feet north of the diesel UST. Benzene, toluene, ethyl benzene. and total xylenes (BTEX) compounds were not detected at standard laboratory reporting limits in soil and groundwater samples.

Next Step - The public is invited to review and comment on the potential closure of the fuel leak case. The entire case file can be viewed over the Internet on the ACEH website (http://www.acgov.org/aceh/lop/ust.htm) or the State of California Water Resources Control Board GeoTracker website (http://geotracker.swrcb.ca.gov). Please send written comments to Karel Detterman at the address below; all comments will be forwarded to the responsible parties. Comments received by May 6, 2013 will be considered and responded to prior to a final determination on the proposed case closure.
