Hi Jesse: The public comment period closed for the case on Monday, 5/6/2013 and ACEH did not receive any comments.

Here are the next steps to finish the case closure process so that you can receive the "Remedial Action Completion Certificate" by June 30, 2013:

1. Please confirm and e-mail the scheduled date that your consultant will decommission the groundwater monitoring well.
2. After well decommissioning, your consultant will prepare a "Well Decommissioning Report" & upload it to our ftp site and Geotracker. This is due by June 14, 2013.
3. When I receive notification of #2, ACEH can issue the "Remedial Action Completion Certificate" and the Fuel Leak case will be closed.
