Mark,
The tank was discovered just prior to the removal. The compliance staff was not aware of the presence of the tank due to install in 1940s. There was no obvious way of identifying the presence of a tank. One of the janitors that worked at

the school pointed it out to Karen Langmaid during an exhaustive audit of all hazmats on the site. We were never aware of the UST so we never requested permitting.
