Trade V/Ms with Paul Dixon this week; finally connect this AM Paul Dixon called to relay status for this site - CA Army National Guard.

They have sent the info to DTSC and Neil Hutchinson has reviewed and says they are exempt from full DTSC process. He works partly through CDE (somebody O'Neil). CDE is getting a request for DTSC to generate a finding, but that will take a bit of time (two steps to get written item). DTSC also recommended that an independent consultant review the site data for risk. Eco-Logic has done, and will be writing something. They had no concerns in regards to the former UST (apparently no naphtha issue), but had a minor asbestos issue (concentration is 0.003% over DTSC value). Apparently Neil H. is not concerned, so Eco-Logic can accept. Paul wants to know if he can approve a contactor getting on site with that info. I ask for submittal of the DTSC finding, and the Eco-Logic risk report before I can make a judgment. It sounds like a limited issue, especially since the LTCP allows much higher contamination to remain in place, but I won't know until I can review the data. Site will be a Digital Arts facility, to be leased.
