Please see the attached analytical results. I apologize for the late information, but I just received the results and wanted to get them to you ASAP, so I didn't tabulate yet. I did want to send the partials in the event you were there late tonight. We are planning on completing backfilling activities tomorrow (Tuesday 5th) as soon as we hear from you. Please note that additional excavation towards Park Street is not possible due to stability and geotech issues, but we have completed the excavation beyond the footprint of the proposed building. Overall the results look great. Please note that SWW-6 indicates the sample was collected at 6 feet below grade, and where deeper contamination was observed, it was not seen in the shallower samples. Furthermore, please note that SW5 should be SWS as shown on the figure I sent you.

Could you please confirm that these results are acceptable and we can continue with the backfilling activities? Please call my cell ASAP as we do not anticipate you will have any issues with these results and would like to proceed.
