Hello Jeff and Vicki:

Thank you for submitting the Soil and Groundwater Investigation Work Plan Addendum (Addendum) dated November 22, 2013, submitted on your behalf by Stratus Environmental, Inc. (Stratus). Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) has reviewed the case file and the Addendum, which proposes drilling four soil borings adjacent to underground storage tank (UST) removal confirmation sample 9325-EX-W-16 and collecting soil and grab groundwater samples from the boring.

Based on ACEH staff review of the Addendum, the proposed scope of work is approved for implementation. We request that you perform the proposed work and send us the report described below.
