Ladies and Gentlemen:

Thank you for participating in the conference call with Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) on May 3, 2017. The purpose of the teleconference was to discuss the case with respect to the California State Water Resources Control Board's (SWRCB's) Low Threat Closure Policy (LTCP), encourage cooperation between the named Responsible Parties (RPs), and collectively implement ACDEH's February 10, 2014 Directive Letter. The purpose of this letter is to summarize the highlights of the conference call and resulting regulatory due dates.

COMMENTS

1. Responsible Party Identification


At this time, it appears appropriate to discuss the definition of Responsible Party and how it is applied in this case. According to California Code of Regulations, Division 3, Chapter 16, §2720, "Responsible Party" means one or more of the following:

1. Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance;

- 2. In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use;
- 3. Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred; and
- 4. Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance.

ACDEH reviewed the September 26, 2016 Notice of Responsibility (NOR) in which Responsible Parties (RPs) were named. Please refer to Attachment 2, *Responsible Party Identification for CST Brands, Inc.* The Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) of the site located at 7701 Bancroft Avenue, Oakland is 40-3388-4-4. According to the County of Alameda Assessor's Office Property Value System which provides the historical succession of property owners, the parcel was purchased or acquired by Gulf Oil Corporation on January 31, 1962. Gulf Oil Corporation was succeeded by Standard Oil of California, and then Chevron. Chevron, as a successor to the Gulf Oil Corporation, is a responsible party because they owned or operated underground storage tanks (USTs) used for the storage of any hazardous substance (Definition 1), in the case of any USTs no longer in use, they owned and operated the USTs immediately before the discontinuation of their use (Definition 2), and they were the property owner where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from the USTs occurred (Definition 3).

Responsible Party Identification for CST Brand, Inc. Stop N Go Station, 7701 Bancroft Ave, Oakland



On December 13, 1973, National Convenience Stores Incorporated (NCS, operating under the name Stop N Go) purchased or acquired the property in December 13, 1973. NCS was acquired by Diamond Shamrock in 1995; Diamond Shamrock was acquired in 1996 by Ultramar and was renamed Ultramar Diamond Shamrock. Ultramar Diamond Shamrock was acquired by Valero Energy Corporation in 2001. In 2013 Valero Energy Corporation spins off CST Brands, Inc. CST Brands, Inc., as a successor to NCS, is a responsible party because they owned or operated the USTs used for the storage of any hazardous substance (Definition 1), in the case of any USTs no longer in use, they owned and operated the USTs immediately before the discontinuation of their use (Definition 2), and they were the property owner where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from the USTs occurred (Definition 3). Please see successorship history (next page) and Attachment 3, Deed and Sale Documentation.

Successor History for CST Brands, Inc.



Bancroft and 77th, LLC, purchased or acquired the property on May 4, 2015. Bancroft and 77th, LLC is a responsible party for the site because it owns the property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from a UST occurred (Definition 3).

There is no known environmental documentation associated with either gasoline service station, which operated between 1962 to 1969 and 1973 to the mid 1980's because this era preceded the start of UST regulations (January 1, 1984). Each gasoline service station operated USTs for approximately 10 years. Consequently, irrespective of when, where, or how the UST system experienced unauthorized release(s), ACDEH applies definitions 1, 2, and 3 to the property owners of both gasoline service stations. Bancroft and 77th, LLC, the current property owner, is named an RP because they bought property contaminated by unauthorized release(s) from USTs. ACDEH applies definition 3 to Bancroft and 77th, LLC. Therefore, Chevron, CST Brands, and Bancroft and 77th, LLC appear to satisfy the definition of Responsible Party.

Despite the evidence, CST Brands, Inc. contends that they are not a Responsible Party at the subject site. ACDEH requests that CST Brands, Inc. forward any information or documentation to refute responsible party status within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. Should no documentation be found to relieve CST Brands, Inc. of their cleanup liability, ACDEH expects that CST Brands, Inc. work cooperatively with the other responsible parties to expedite site characterization and/or cleanup.

2. Resolution of the Approved but not Implemented Work Plan:

In 2015 Bancroft and 77th, LLC contracted with Pangea Environmental Services, Inc. (Pangea) to conduct a soil gas survey at the site to evaluate the potential for vapor intrusion for current use and potential future site buildings. Pangea submitted a *Soil Gas Sampling Report* (Soil Gas Report) dated December 18, 2015 to Bancroft and 77th, LLC, but the work was not conducted under ACDEH's oversight. The Soil Gas Report was submitted to ACDEH on May 13, 2016 and to Geotracker on April 28, 2016.

On June 24, 2016 ACDEH reviewed and approved the April 27, 2016 *Site Conceptual Model and Data Gap Work Plan* (SCM-Work Plan), prepared and submitted by on behalf of Bancroft and 77th, LLC. On September 7, 2016 Bancroft and 77th, LLC requested a report submittal extension to allow time for additional RPs to participate and ACDEH extended the report due date to November 2, 2016, but the work was not implemented.

3. Return To Compliance:

Implementation of site characterization and/or cleanup at this site is crucial to be protective of human health and the environment and to move this case towards closure evaluation. Please note that as Responsible Parties, you are required by California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 16, Article 11, §2720 through §2728 to characterize the site and implement corrective action.

The site is out of compliance with two ACDEH *Notice to Comply* Directives dated January 7, 2016 and January 18, 2017. To regain compliance, please submit the document(s) as described below. As discussed during the

conference call, failure to submit the requested document to ACDEH by the date provided below will result in case referral to the District Attorney. Pursuant to Chapter 6.7, California Health and Safety code, civil penalties up to \$10,000 for each UST for each day of violation may be imposed. Please note that civil penalties for non-compliance are assessed from the original due date of April 11, 2014 for the SCM and Data Gap Work Plan.

REPORT REQUESTS

These reports are being requested pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party in response to an unauthorized release from a petroleum UST system, and require your compliance with this request.

ELECTRONIC SUBMITTAL OF REPORTS

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health's (ACDEH) Environmental Cleanup Oversight Programs, Local Oversight Program (LOP) and Site Cleanup Program (SCP) require submission of reports in electronic form. The electronic copy replaces paper copies and is expected to be used for all public information requests, regulatory review, and compliance/enforcement activities. Instructions for submission of electronic documents to the Alameda County Environmental Cleanup Oversight Program File Transfer Protocol (FTP) site are provided on the attached "Electronic Report Upload Instructions." Submission of reports to the Alameda County FTP site is an addition to existing requirements for electronic submittal of information to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) GeoTracker website. In September 2004, the SWRCB adopted regulations that require electronic submittal of information for all groundwater cleanup programs. For several years, responsible parties for cleanup of leaks from underground storage tanks (USTs) have been required to submit groundwater analytical data, surveyed locations of monitoring wells, and <u>other</u> data to the GeoTracker database over the Internet. Beginning July 1, 2005, these same reporting requirements were added to SCP sites. Beginning July 1, 2005, electronic submittal of a complete copy of all reports for all sites is required in GeoTracker (in PDF format). Please visit the SWRCB website (<u>http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/water_issues/programs/ust/electronic_submittal/</u>) for more information on these requirements.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT STATEMENT

All work plans, technical reports, or technical documents submitted to ACDEH must be accompanied by a cover letter from the responsible party that states, at a minimum, the following: "I have read and acknowledge the content, recommendations and/or conclusions contained in the attached document or report submitted on my behalf to ACDEH's FTP server and the SWRCB's GeoTracker website." This letter must be signed by an officer or legally authorized representative of your company. Please include a cover letter satisfying these requirements with all future reports and technical documents submitted for this fuel leak case.

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION & CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

The California Business and Professions Code (Sections 6731, 6735, and 7835) requires that work plans and technical or implementation reports containing geologic or engineering evaluations and/or judgments be performed under the direction of an appropriately licensed or certified professional. For your submittal to be considered a valid technical report, you are to present site-specific data, data interpretations, and recommendations prepared by an appropriately licensed professional and include the professional registration stamp, signature, and statement of professional certification. Please ensure all that all technical reports submitted for this case meet this requirement. UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP FUND

Please note that delays in investigation, late reports, or enforcement actions may result in your becoming ineligible to receive grant money from the state's Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund (Senate Bill 2004) to reimburse you for the cost of cleanup.

AGENCY OVERSIGHT

If it appears as though significant delays are occurring or reports are not submitted as requested, we will consider referring your case to the Regional Board or other appropriate agency, including the County District Attorney, for possible enforcement actions. California Health and Safety Code, Section 25299.76 authorizes enforcement including administrative action or monetary penalties of up to \$10,000 per day for each day of violation.






Attachment 2 Responsible Party Identification for CST Brands, Inc. Stop N Go Station, 7701 Bancroft Ave, Oakland



Successor History for CST Brands, Inc.




