The above referenced site is a Site Cleanup Program (SCP) case that is under the regulatory oversight of the Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) for the investigation and cleanup of a petroleum hydrocarbon release from two 300-gallon underground storage tanks (USTs) that were removed from beneath the sidewalk in 2004. Site investigation and cleanup activities have been completed and it does not appear that residual contamination presents a risk to human health and the environment. Therefore, ACEH is considering closure of the case. Due to the residual contamination on site, the site would be closed with site management requirements that require further evaluation if the site is to be redeveloped in the future.

This notice is being sent to the current occupants and landowners of adjacent properties and known interested parties for this site. The public is invited to review and comment on the potential closure of the case.
