Alameda County Environmental Health has reviewed the "Request to Reduce Air Monitoring Activities at the Public Storage Construction Site," dated May 11, 2015. We have no objections to the proposal to cease analysis of perimeter air samples for lead. Perimeter dust monitoring and observation of proper engineering controls for dust control are to be continued during the duration of soil disturbance for the project.
