
Dear Ms. Roe,

I am writing once again to respectfully request that our case receive the highest priority by your office. This letter is a follow up on the letter dated August 27<sup>th</sup> of 2015. In that letter you may recall that I had twice extended the option to purchase the property where we warehouse our production supplies. I further mentioned that the current owner would likely not extend our option a third time while we work to finalize the Site Management Plan with your office. You also may recall that we had completed the public comment period and your office was preparing to close our case when you requested a soil vapor test.

As I expected, the building owner would not agree to extend our option any longer so my partners and I decided to exercise the existing option without the closure letter I had hoped to receive from ACEH. Because we have an open case with ACEH we are not able to receive commercial financing and we now have all our business capital tied up in this building.

We have now completed the soil vapor test, prepared and submitted a revised SMP, as well as a Vapor Mitigation Basis of Design Report. We are awaiting a response from your office so that we can proceed with the vapor mitigation and resolve this case as soon as possibly. Your assistance in making this case a priority would be greatly appreciated.
