Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) staff has reviewed the case file including the *Work Plan, Additional Investigation* (Work Plan) dated November 6, 2017, prepared and submitted on your behalf by AEI Consultants (AEI). The Work Plan was submitted in response to a meeting with you and AEI representatives on October 13, 2017. Thank you for submitting the Work Plan.

Based on ACDEH staff review of the Work Plan, the proposed scope of work is conditionally approved for implementation provided that the following technical comments below are incorporated during the proposed work. Submittal of a revised work plan or a work plan addendum is not required unless an alternate scope of work outside that described in the work plan or these technical comments is proposed. We request that you address the following technical comments, perform the proposed work, and send us the report described below. Please provide 72-hour advance written notification to this office (e-mail preferred to: karel.detterman@acgov.org) prior to the start of field activities.

TECHNICAL COMMENTS:

- 1. Soil and Groundwater Analysis: Please analyze all soil and groundwater samples for the full scan of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) using EPA Method 8260B.
- 2. Soil Gas Analysis: Please analyze all soil gas samples for methane, in addition to analysis for VOCs using TO-15 and for oxygen.
- **3. Historical Soil Analytical Table:** Please revise Table 1, *Summary of Shallow Soil Sample Results* to report the actual detection limits for all Non-Detected (ND) results.

TECHNICAL REPORT REQUEST:

Please upload the technical report to the State Water Resources Control Board's Geotracker website, in accordance with the following specified file naming convention and schedule:

REPORT & DELIVERABLE REQUESTS

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) Cleanup Oversight Programs, Local Oversight Program (LOP) and Site Cleanup Program (SCP) require submission of all reports in electronic form to the State Water Board's (SWB) GeoTracker website in accordance with California Code of Regulations, Chapter 30, Division3, Title 23 and Division 3, Title 27.

Leaking Underground Fuel Tank (LUFT) Cases

Reports and deliverable requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party (RP) in conjunction with an unauthorized release from a petroleum underground storage tank (UST) system.

Site Cleanup Program (SCP) Cases

For non-petroleum UST cases, reports and deliverables requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 101480.

ELECTRONIC SUBMITTAL OF REPORTS

A complete report submittal includes the PDF report and all associated electronic data files, including but not limited to GEO_MAP, GEO_XY, GEO_Z, GEO_BORE, GEO_WELL, and laboratory analytical data in Electronic Deliverable Format[™] (EDF). - Do not upload draft reports to GeoTracker
