Hello Everett:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the case file including the *Addendum* to Work Plan for Additional Subsurface Investigation (Addendum) dated July 15, 2015 prepared and submitted on your behalf by Essel Environmental Consulting (Essel). Thank you for submitting the Addendum.

ACEH staff has reviewed the case file, including the Work Plan in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board's (SWRCB) Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (LTCP). Based on our review of available data, the case does not meet General Criteria d (free product removal), f (secondary source removal), Media Specific Criteria for Groundwater, Media-Specific Criteria for Vapor Intrusion to Indoor Air, and Direct Contact and Outdoor Air Exposure.

Based on ACEH staff review of the work plan, the proposed scope of work is conditionally approved for implementation provided that the technical comment below is incorporated during the proposed work. We request that you address the technical comment, perform the proposed work, and send us the report described below. Please provide 72-hour advance written notification to this office (e-mail preferred to: karel.detterman@acgov.org) prior to the start of field activities.

TECHNICAL COMMENT

1. Soil Vapor Testing: The two permanent soil vapor wells proposed for installation should be sampled irrespective of analytical soil and groundwater results found in the secondary source material areas. Soil vapor results are important especially in the absence of a bioattenuation zone and the LTCP presents soil gas criteria.
