Mr. Lee and Ms. D'Hondt,

I spoke with your consultant Bill Dugan on Friday March 25<sup>th</sup> in regards to the recommendations contained in the March 4, 2016 indoor air vapor investigation report (submitted March 23, 2016), and in general identified a path forward for the site, and potential scope of work for the next step. Bill thought he could submit a work plan by Monday April 4 2016, provided he and you could reach an agreement on the scope of work and associated costs. The intent was to minimize the work plan writeup since standard protocols are largely in place. Since it has been two Monday's since the potential identified submittal date I wanted to followup on the status of the work. The recent work only partly determined the level of protection from PCE in adjacent commercial suites at the site as the lower detection limits were generally above acceptable Environmental Screening Levels (ESLs) promulgated by the San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB). The work identified was to resample a number of the suites in an attempt to determine the level of worker safety to chemical exposure in each commercial suite.

I can respond formally to the submitted site indoor vapor investigation, but have not in an effort to speed the process. Please keep me posted as to the status of the work plan for the site. Should you have questions, please let me know.
